BOYS SPORTS CAMP & GIRLS LIFETIME ADVENTURE CAMP



Boys Sports Camp (Grades 4–8) is the total package for boys. Campers receive instruction in the fundamentals of a variety of sports, engage in healthy intramural competition and enjoy fun field trips all over the Cleveland area.

Girls Lifetime Adventure Camp (Grades 4–8) goes beyond the scope of the day camp program, providing activities and experiences that are enjoyable. We aim to empower girls in developmentally appropriate ways by providing them with daily choices based on their interests.

TRANSPORTATION

In most cases, buses or vans are scheduled to pick up and drop off campers at their homes. Depending on the camper's proximity to the Lyndhurst and Gates Mills campuses, pick-up will occur between 8:00 am and 8:45 am each day. At the end of the day, vehicles will depart at 4:00 pm for the return trip, with most campers being dropped off before 5:00 pm.
